Eligibility

The Education Equality Project (EEP) iPod Contest is offered to anyone who submits a valid contest submission to our website. A valid submission must include the entrant's email address, the name of the song he or she is submitting, the artist, and a brief explanation of why he/she is nominating the song. Please note an individual may submit more than one entry, but each entry must be unique – i.e., a different song and explanation.

Promotional Period

Three Apple iPods will be given away at the conclusion of the promotional period.

The Contest begins January 6th 2010 and ends February 14th 2010 at 9:00pm EST.

Entry

Submit the song you think best fits our mission, plus a sentence or two telling us why by February 14, 2010. The winner and two runners-up get iPods loaded with the best entries and a play-list of our signatories' favorite songs.

No purchase necessary to enter or win. You may enter by signing up at www.edequality.org/page/s/ipodcontest. All entries must be received during the Promotional Period.

No responsibility is assumed by EEP for lost, late, or misdirected entries or for any human, computer, online, telephone, or technical malfunctions that may occur. All entries become the property of EEP and will not be returned to the entrant. Please note, EEP has the right to post all entries anonymously (i.e., the title of the song and its artist) to its website. On the entry page we ask entrants if they will allow us to post their name with their entry. We will only post entrants' names in association with their entries if they indicate their permission via the entry form (<http://www.edequality.org/page/s/ipodcontest>).

Drawing

One winner and two runners-up will be selected from all eligible entries based upon the quality of the submissions at the end of the promotional period. The winner and two runners-up will be notified by e-mail on or about five days after the selection process has been concluded.

Prize & Odds of Winning

The winner will receive an 8GB iPod Nano, approximate retail value: \$199.99. Two runners-up will receive iPod Shuffles, each valued at approximately \$59.00. Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the promotional period and the submissions that best fit the contest's guidelines.
